# ERADICATION OF EQUINE INFLUENZA





- The Equine industry has 900,000+ horses from the organized in Racing to the recreational horse and ferals. A significant contributor to the Australian Economy in every indicator.
- Harness Racing Australia, Australian Racing Board and Australian Horse Industry Council. Co-operation within the Australian Horse Industry displayed.

#### KEY EAD RESPONSE ISSUES



Equine Influenza

- STATE SIZE/DIMENSION & Highly Contagious Spread in a naïve horse population.
- Suspension of Horse Movement, Containment.
- Horse Traceability and Location by Zones.
- Mobilization of Resources, Government and Veterinary.
- Key Role of Chief Veterinary Officers & Staff with 'Whole of Government' Capability.

#### KEY EAD RESPONSE ISSUES



Equine Influenza

- Communication, all facets & mediums.
  - Equine Influenza Forum by Harness Racing Australia.
- Testing Samples & Research (Laboratories).
- Vaccination to support containment & eradication.
- Artificial Insemination & Semen Transportation vital for Harness Racing Breeding Industry.



#### <u>ACHIEVEMENT</u>

 ERADICATION succeeded, NOT declared ENDEMIC

Regular Vaccination <u>NOT REQUIRED.</u>
 This costly alternative is not necessary.

Harness Racing Australia's Policy is that periodic vaccination into the future does <u>not</u> occur.

#### **FUTURE FOCUS**



- Emergency Disease Response notified by Federal Minster Tony Burke as from 30 June 2008, that Australia is "free of disease" status.
- Direction focussed on 'Proof of Freedom' under O.I.E. requirements by end of December 2008. Extensive testing undertaken for international purposes.
- Removal of all import/export restrictions on horse movement internationally, emphasizing New Zealand/Australia movement reinstatement.

#### **FUTURE FOCUS**



- Finalization of Government Administrative and Contractual Agreement through Animal Health Australia.
- Total Review of Emergency Disease Response with Animal Health Australia for equine and all livestock industries.
