AUCKLAND TROTTING CLUB

REGULATIONS UNDER "THE GAMING ACT, 1908"

N.Z.G., 1923, P.2377.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in Section 33 of "The Gaming Act, 1908", and of all other powers and authorities, it enabling in that behalf the Auckland Trotting Club, a trotting club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said Club") doth hereby revoke the regulations dated the 14th day of February, 1919, and in lieu thereof doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admissions of persons to that part of the Auckland Trotting Club's Course, situated in the District of One Tree Hill, and known as the Auckland Trotting Club's Racecourse while the said Racecourse is used or occupied by the said Club for race meetings.

1. These Regulations shall come into force on the date of the same being published in the "New Zealand Gazette."

2. In these Regulations the words "Bookmaker", "Trotting Club", and "Race Meeting" shall have the meaning ascribed to those terms respectively by Section 2 of The Gaming Act, 1908".

3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the Racecourse above described while the same is used or occupied by the said Club for a race meeting, namely:—

- (a) Bookmakers.
- (b) Bookmakers' Clerks, Bookmakers' Assistants and Bookmakers' Agents.
- (c) All persons under disqualification inflicted by any racing or trotting club in the Dominion of New Zealand, the Commonwealth of Australia, or elsewhere, if affiliated to the New Zealand Racing Conference, or the New Zealand Trotting Association, or the New Zealand Trotting Conference.
- (d) Common prostitutes and persons who habitually consort with thieves or with persons who have no lawful visible means of support.
- (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house-breaking or pocket-picking, forgery, uttering, or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under "The Crimes Act, 1908", and also idle and disorderly persons, rogues and vagabonds, and incorrigible rogues convicted under "The Police Offences Act, 1908", and persons convicted of an offence under "The Gaming Act, 1908".

The foregoing Regulations of the Auckland Trotting Club were made and passed by the Auckland Trotting Club on the twenty-first (21st) day of August, 1923, and signed by the Chairman and Secretary.

The Selling Windows for the Doubles Totalisator will open at

The Doubles Totalisator shall be conducted so that there shall
be a separate pool from the pool of any other totalisator operating
on one race only.

The Doubles Totalisator on the First Leg will close 10 minutes
prior to the Win and Place Totalisator on such race.

Holders of winning tickets in the First Leg must change their
tickets for the horse or horses they wish to support for the second
race of the Double.

Investors failing to change their winning tickets on the First
Race of the Double before the Doubles Totalisator closes for the
Second Race of the Double shall have no further interest or claim
in or upon any amount invested and shall not be entitled to any
refund.

If there be a dead-heat the right of holders to tickets on the
Starters so dead-heating shall be determined in accordance with
the regulations.

If a horse is scratched or declared not in the Starter's Hands
for the Second Race the holder may change his ticket for a starter.

If no authority for the payment of a dividend on the winner of
the First Race has been given by the Stewards within thirty
minutes of the appointed starting time of the Second Race, the
Double will be deemed to be void and the amount available for
dividend shall be divided equally amongst the holders of tickets on
the horse subsequently declared to be the First Horse in the First
Race, or, if there are no holders of tickets on the First Horse,
then in the manner provided in the Regulations.

Any question or dispute arising out of the interpretation of
these Regulations, or which is not covered by these Regulations,
shall be referred to the Committee of the Club, whose decision
shall be final and binding.
