## **Operates on All Races**

The "Quinella" Totalisator is conducted on all races of the programme. You must choose two horses to fill the first and second places irrespective of the order in which they finish. Tickets are sold at 5/- each. There is no limit to the number of tickets which may be purchased, and please ask for horse numbers in race book order.

In the event of a "carry-over" on any "Quinella", it shall be transferred into the Pool of the first Quinella (2nd Race) of the next meeting at Gloucester Park. In the event of there being 2 or more "carry-overs" at the one meeting, the first "carry-over" shall be transferred into the Pool of the second race Quinella of the next meeting and the other or others shall be transferred to a race or races to be decided by the committee of the Association.

#### "FIELD" TICKETS

Investors may purchase "Field" Tickets; taking one horse (or No.) with the remainder of the Field (or Nos.) for which one ticket will be issued.

#### REFUNDS ON NON-STARTERS

Investments on the "Quinella" Totalisator on any combination which includes a non-starter shall be refunded in full upon production and delivery of the ticket.

(A Warning Bell rings and Red Lights are shown five minutes before closing of Totalisator)

Of £800; first horse to receive £560; second horse £150; third horse £60. The horse recording fastest time in each division will receive £30 out of the stake:

Open to approved horses registered with the Controlling Bodies of New Zealand and each State of the Commonwealth of Australia.

The Championships will be restricted to pacers and conducted on the points system. Points will be awarded as follows in each division: First horse 4 points; second horse 2 points; third horse 1 point and the horse recording the fastest time in each division will receive 3 points. The maximum handicaps will be 36 yards up to 12 furlongs and 48 yards over longer distances.

The horses gaining the greatest aggregate of points will be eligible to start in the Final. The Final will be for 12 horses. The Committee of the W.A.T.A. on the recommendation of the Grand Council, may extend the maximum number of starters to 14.

In the event of dead heats, the points of placed horses deadheating shall be added and divided equally.

The Winner of the Championship is to be the horse declared first in the Grand Final. To be eligible to start in the Grand Final, horses must compete in all qualifying divisions unless exemption is granted to meet special circumstances.

A driver of a competing horse may protest against the winner, or any placed horse on the ground of interference, crossing, jostling, or any improper act or conduct of the driver of such horse. The protest must be made to a Steward or Clerk of the Scales BEFORE THE DRIVER LEAVES THE SCALES after weighing in.

#### BOOKMAKERS
