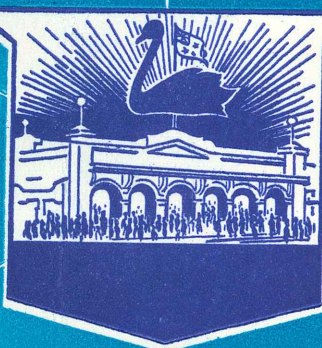

Of £1,000; first horse to receive £665; second horse £190; third horse £95. Horse recording fastest time, will receive £50 out of the stake.

Open to approved horses registered with the Controlling Bodies of New Zealand and each State of the Commonwealth of Australia.

The Championships will be restricted to pacers and conducted on the points system. Points will be awarded as follows in each division: First horse 4 points; second horse 2 points; third horse 1 point and the horse recording the fastest time in each division will receive 3 points. The maximum handicaps will be 36 yards up to 12 furlongs and 48 yards over longer distances.

The horses gaining the greatest aggregate of points will be eligible to start in the Final. The Final will be for 12 horses. The Committee of the W.A.T.A. on the recommendation of the Grand Council, may extend the maximum number of starters to 14.

In the event of dead heats, the points of placed horses dead-heating shall be added and divided equally.

NOTICE TO PATRONS

CONDITIONS OF RACING

All races to be run under the Rules of Racing made under the Constitution and Rules of the Western Australian Trotting Association.

In all races when two or more horses are on identical marks, the horse whose name appears first will occupy No. 1 pole position, the other positions following in rotation.

REFUSAL OF NOMINATION

The Committee may, in its absolute discretion, at any time after receipt of a nomination, cancel the same without giving any reason therefor.

RE-HANDICAPPING OF HORSES

If, after the handicaps are declared for a race, a horse wins or is placed in another race, the handicap of that horse may be re-adjusted by the Handicapper.

STARTING

Horses are under the starter's orders after the whistle has been blown to take their position at the barriers.

PROTESTS

A driver of a competing horse may protest against the winner, or any placed horse on the ground of interference, crossing, jostling, or any improper act or conduct of the driver of such horse. The protest must be made to a Steward or Clerk of the Scales BEFORE THE DRIVER LEAVES THE SCALES after weighing in.

BOOKMAKERS

The public is notified that Bookmakers fielding in the Enclosure must set the Investor up to £100 on the prices shown on the board, and in the Leger, up to £25. In the event of a dead heat, payment will be made on a basis of half of value of the ticket.

A Horn will be blown in the Enclosure Bookmakers' Ring as the horses are called to the barrier. (Approx. 3 minutes to the start of each race.)

On all Betting tickets issued by Bookmakers, the name of the Horse and the amount of the Bet must be clearly written. Should a dispute arise and it is found that this has not been done, a decision may be given against the Bookmaker.

Investors must check their ticket for the correct Name of Horse and Amount, as no claim will be recognised after the acceptance of the Ticket.

LOST BETTING TICKETS
