STEWARDS' REPORT

WAYVILLE - SATURDAY, 9th FEBRUARY, 1963

Perth Handicap:

J. May (FREMONT'S PEAK) was reprimanded for causing slight interference to GALWAY STAR.

Inter-Dominion Championship (1st Div.):

SMOKEY ERIC, KOL'S IDOL and JIVE were slowly away. Later JIVE choked, causing interference to LEW'S HOPE and EL TEGRA.

DELA PRIDE bled during the running of the race and, on Veterinary advice, will be withdrawn from all further engagements in the Championships.

Inter-Dominion Championship (2nd Div.):

E. Kennerly (WAITAKI HANOVER) had his reinsmen's licence suspended for one month for careless driving after his horse had broken, causing interference to MAJESTIC SON. As a result of this incident COLUMBUS and SHEFFIELD GLOBE were severely checked.

A. Turner (MARY KATHLEEN) and G. Gilbert (SHADY ACRES) were told that better performances were expected from them at the barrier at next appearance.

Sydney Handicap: TACTILE (D. Townley) and JENNIFER SCOTT (B. Nolan) both missed the start. INTELLIGENT (L. Bastin) received interference from the breaking JENNIFER SCOTT.

Inter-Dominion Championship (4th Div.):
An enquiry into the accident involving VEEBEEAH, FIRST DIVISION, CELE, OPAL CHIEF, JIDALUK and RAPALAN was opened and adjourned until 6.30 p.m. on Wednesday evening.

A protest was lodged by R. Robinson (MAYFIELD SCOTT) against the second horse (MARY MAVIS) for alleged interference at the turn into the home straight. The protest was upheld on the observations of the Stewards and on the evidence given by the drivers. W. Picken (MARY MAVIS) will be called before the Stewards on Wednesday night.

P. Wolfenden (CARDIGAN BAY) was reprimanded for allowing his horse to drift in at the turn out of the back straight with two laps to go, causing interference to LITTLE PRINCE. Wolfenden stated his horse made the turn into the straight badly and had too much pace to make the far turn cleanly. It was the horse's first run on the track.
