Permission granted for Dolly Vardon blinkers on LORD ATHLONE.

### Perth Handicap:

A warning was issued to the connections of GENTLE ADIOS in respect to the horse's bad get-away and informed that improvement will be expected next start.

K. Brook (SUNSET GLORY) and R. Cox (GENTLE ADIOS) were questioned in reference to an incident which happened just past the winning post with two laps to go when SUNSET GLORY moved to make a run. He slightly embarrassed GENTLE ADIOS (R. Cox) but immediately he pulled his horse off. As it was a borderline case, no action was taken.

### Inter-Dominion (1st Qualifying Race):

The Stewards enquired into an incident concerning MASTER CLAN (J. Schrader), BOLD DAVID (A. Simons) and MAJOR WINSTON (L. Moulds). As a result the Stewards were of the opinion that A. Simons, the driver of BOLD DAVID, came out too sharply, causing MASTER CLAN to break. He therefore was fined the sum of twenty dollars and informed that a similar case would be more severely dealt with.

### Inter-Dominion (2nd Qualifying Race):

The Stewards opened an enquiry into the incident involving BON ADIOS when W. Shinn was unseated from his gig. This has also been adjourned till next Wednesday night at 7 p.m., to enable W. Shinn to give evidence. The incident involved SMART FANCY (F. Wilkins).

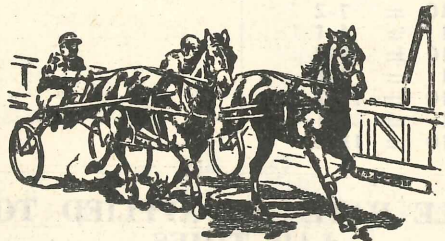

## Extracts from Regulations under Lottery and Gaming Acts

### CONTROL OF QUEUES

7. (1) Persons approaching any window of a Totalisator shall form up in a queue in single file extending away from such window.

(2) When any such queue has been formed, no person shall approach the window to which such queue leads except as a member of such queue.

8. No persons shall —

(a) push into any such queue, or join the same except at the end thereof;

(b) take precedence of any person who from his position has a prior right in any queue;

(c) stand or walk between any queue so formed, or within four yards of either side of the outside queues;

(d) pass money or a ticket to any person in any queue.

9. Every person shall at all times observe and comply with any reasonable direction by any member of the Police Force as to:—

(a) the manner of approaching to or departing from any totalisator;

(b) the conduct of such person in the vicinity of any totalisator.

### PENALTIES

10. Any person who contravenes any provision of regulation 7, 8, or 9 hereof, whether by omission or commission, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$20 for every breach of such provision.
