#### **COLLECTION OF TOTE DIVIDENDS**

#### **FAVOUT BETTING**

'FAVOUT' BETTING is a mode of betting whereby punters can bet on a race which has a prohibitive odds-on favourite (1/4 or shorter) as if that horse was not in the field.

Such a horse is called a "designated horse" and bookmakers approved for FAVOUT betting shall not display odds for the "designated horse"

Approved FAVOUT bookmakers shall pay bets as if the "designated horse" was not in the field. That is, if the "designated horse" runs a placing, it is ignored completely and the fourth horse is promoted to third.

The Chairman of Stewards shall declare the FAVOUT placings prior to the "All Clear" being notified and they shall be announced over the Public Address System.

TWIN FALLS STAKES: Near the winning post on the first occasion, "Hughie Brae (G. Norman) hung in tightening the groundon "Salzburg" (V. J. Knight), which was taken down on to "Computer Code" (L. J. O'Bree). "Computer Code was also tightened forroom, and taken in on to "Great Rival" (Leonie Collins), which had to be checked.A warning was issued regarding "Hughie Brae"hanging. The first half of the last mile was covered in 64 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Batik Print" (C. A. Alford), the winner of the race.

ESANDA THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES STAKES: "Satin Silhouette" (T. A. Dove) hung in throughout the race, and tired badly over the concluding stages. It was noted on return to scale that "Satin Silhouette" (T. A. Dove) suffereda flat tyre during this event.The Stewards questioned V. J. Knight "Bye Bye Sailor", W. D. Bottrell Chantilly Rainbow" and A. D. Peace questioned V. J. Knight "Bye Bye Sailor", W. D. Bottrell Chantilly Rainbow" and A. D. Peace "Rich Titian" regarding an incident which occurred near the 400 metres where "Bye Bye Sailor" had to be checked. It was found to have been caused when "Krystal Kelly" (Judith K. Rutland) moved offthe rail near the 500 metres, which resulted in "Rich Titian" losingits position in the one wide line, and "Chantilly Rainbow" being able to move into the one wide ine. "Bye Bye Sailor" was unable to move wider as "LowRisk" (J. J. Caldow) was on its outside, and was unable to go to the rail as Annie Woodstock" (Gavin Lang) was inside the wheels of "Bye Bye Sailor". Soon after getting into the one wide line, "Chantilly Rainbow" compounded, causing "Bye Bye Sailor" to be checked off the sulky of "Chantilly Rainbow". "Bye Bye Sailor" raced roughly as a result, and "Annie Woodstock" had to be checked and broke for a few strides Judith K. Rutland was reprimanded forher abrupt movement near the 500 metres, and W. D. Bottrell was informed that the Stewards would expect him to show more 500 metres, and W. D. Bottrell was informed that the Stewards would expect him to show more initiative and sum up the chances of his horse prior to shifting ground. The first half of the last mile was covered in 64 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "Spring Wiper" (M. N. Wishart), the winner of the race.

Basilone) hung in, tightening the ground on Gemistorie Pat (D. B. Gatil). Spaler raid continued to hang throughout the race. A warningwas issued regarding this horse's racing habits. "Emergo" (G. H. Williams) was slow to begin.V. J. Knight "Khmer Jitsu" was reprimanded for continually looking around during this event. "Bank on a Touch Down" (Dennis W. Wills) was tightened for room near the finish when "Just Distinctive" (A. D. Peace) hung in and tightened the ground of "Emergo" (G. H. Williams), which, in turn, tightened "Bank on a Touch Down". The first half of the last mile was covered in 60.9 seconds. A swab sample

was taken from "Khmer Jitsu" (V. J. Knight), the winner of the race.

HILARIOUS WAY STAKES: "Winning Victory" (A. D. Peace) hung in during the score-up, and lost ground as a result.Near the 1100 metres, when moving forward, "Preux Amara" (V. J. Bottrell "Happy Haldon" was fined the sum of \$100 under Rule 268(a) regarding the manner in which he used his whip over the concluding stages. "Family Way" (G. A. Dalton) began slowly. The Stewards ordered the withdrawal of "Classy Pony" at 6.05 p.m. afterconfirming a phone call from trainer T. R. Lamont, who informed them that this horse had injured itself while being loaded on to the float and was unfit to take its place in the field. The first half of the last mile was covered in 62.7 seconds. Aswab sample was taken from "Jane Ellen" (V. J. Knight), the winner of the race.T. E. Demmler "Birdswood" was fined \$25 underRule 370(b) for

dropping his whip near the 200 metres.

E.B.COCHRAN TROTTERS CUP: The Stewards ordered the withdrawal of "YankeeLoch" and "Tyron Scottie" at 11.18 a.m. when it was found that the plane, which was to have brought these horses from New Zealand, was delayed, and it wasdoubtful whether the horses would arrive in time. "True Roman" (Gavin Lang) was unable to occupy its barrier position in the early part of the score-up when "Glenfield Girl (I. R. Lee) trailed the wrong number.N. J. Clarke part of the score-up when "Glentield Girl (I. H. Lee) trailed in ewrong number. N. J. Clarke "Suave Guy" was reprimanded for allowing thishorse to shift inturning out of the back straight on the first occasion, causing "Kano Joe (W. J. Bond) and "Hot and Dry" (G. R. Conroy) to be tightened for room. "Fair Tally" (Kathleen A. Ford) broke near the 600 metres for a few strides, and again near the finish when under pressure. "Kano Joe" (W. J. Bond) broke under pressure over the concluding stages. The first half of the last mile was covered in 63.2 seconds. A swab sample was taken from "True Roman" (Gavin Lang), the winner of the race.

The Sectional Time Requirements for Moonee Valley are as follows:

(a) Drivers are required to complete the first half of the mile in 65 seconds for Metropolitan Penalty Bearing (MPB) races and 67 seconds for other events excluding 2YO and 3YO trotters races and races over a distance longer than 2380 metres.

(b) A concession of 1 second in the Sectional Time Requirement for will apply for MPB races conducted over 2380 metres when the first portion of the race to the mile point is completed in 59 seconds or less.


